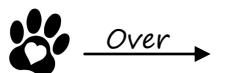

How You Can Help!

Below are the current volunteer positions along with a brief description in order to give you an idea of what is available.

Cat Socialization

Help increase the adoptability of PARL's cats by providing socialization and one-on-one attention. Ensure that individual cat cages and cat adoption room remains clean and welcoming for cats and adopters. Assist the public that have general questions about the adoption process.

Small Animal Socialization

Help increase the adoptability of PARL's rabbits and other small animals by providing socialization and one-on-one attention. Ensure that individual cat cages and small animal room remains clean and welcoming for small animals and adopters. Assist the public that have general questions about the adoption process.

PetSmart Cat Caretaker

Help increase the adoptability of PARL's cats that are at the PetSmart Adoption Center in Warwick by providing socialization and one-on-one attention. Ensure that individual cat cages remain clean and welcoming for visitors. Assist the public that have general questions about the adoption process. One consistent shift per week is required for this position.

Special Events

Assist Events Manager with managing, coordinating and implementing fundraising events to generate unrestricted funds for the Providence Animal Rescue League. The Event Volunteers work closely with the Events Manager to assist with many aspects of PARL's community, signature and internal events.

Promotion Distribution

Work independently or get a team together and help us get the word out about PARL! Assist us by distributing printed materials in our community such as libraries, coffee shops, pet stores and schools. Materials include posters, brochures and adoptable animal flyers. This is a great way for you to help our animals even if you limited time to volunteer!

Administrative Assistance

Assist with daily administrative activities including data entry, mailings and special projects. Duties vary and will provide support for our special events and marketing departments. Flexible commitment depending on need.

Foster Care

Assist us by taking animals into your home to allow them the time and attention then need before coming back to the shelter for adoption. Foster care for animals is needed for a variety of reasons, the most common being underage kittens. By opening your home you will play a crucial role in providing them with the care and compassion needed to help place them into
